



AMTN MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

Membership Eligibility

Membership is open to all professional massage therapists who undertake massage therapy services, students enrolled in the study of massage therapy in order to practice these services, and teachers and lecturers in Massage Therapy.

Membership Application and Approval Process

Membership of the Australian Massage Therapist Network (AMTN) can be requested by completing a AMTN Membership Application form. The application and approval process is as follows:

1. A completed application form is to be posted or faxed to the Australian Massage Therapists Network. Receipt of this form is taken as an indication that you have read and understood the Membership Agreement

A levy or subscription of \$20.00 is requested but not mandatory when renewing membership and can be paid by Cheque, postal order or credit card.

3. On receipt of Membership application, the application will be processed and verified. On acceptance, the AMTN will forward a Certificate of Membership. Membership details including a unique membership number will also be forwarded.

Levy Structure for AMTN Memberships

From 2008, a small voluntary levy of \$20.00 has been requested to support the maintenance costs of the AMTN Web and the organisation's projects which include our "regional pages" and on-line forum co-ordination. Levies do not include GST, this tax is not collected.

AMTN MANAGEMENT

AMTN is co-ordinated by therapists, industry representatives and educators who volunteer their time and expertise to provide a means for massage practitioners and students of massage to access current and relevant information about their industry and their work.
